5FUDD is a patented combination of the following FDA approved topical medications:

- <u>5-fluorouracil 2.5%:</u> chemotherapeutic agent
- <u>Calcipotriene 0.005%</u>: Vitamin D derivative that acts to boost immunity which allows for a quicker and more effective response with longer lasting results
- <u>Diclofenac 3%:</u> non-steroidal anti-inflammatory agent used to aid in healing

Dr. Glazer designates this novel formulation as a "smart cream" as it selectively destroys precancerous and cancerous cells while sparing normal tissue. The cream is providing excellent cosmetic results and cure rates that are best in class.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR 5FUDD

Instructions:

- 1. Wash the treatment area(s) with gentle cleanser/soap and water. Allow your skin to dry completely.
- 2. Apply a <u>thin layer</u> to the treatment area(s) with your finger or a q-tip and rub thoroughly into skin.
 - **If you are treating the entire face (forehead, temples, cheeks, and nose), we suggest a pea-sized amount. Remember, a little goes a long way.**
- 3. Wash your hands thoroughly after each application.

What to expect:

- Reaction will begin 2-3 days after starting treatment
- Expect area(s) to look pink/red, become irritated, and/or have scabbing. Skin might feel like a bad sunburn or "tight."
- Irritation might spread further than anticipated remember the cream is selective to even microscopic sun damaged skin, but will leave normal healthy cells alone. A "bad reaction" is a good therapeutic response!
- Reaction will continue to worsen throughout application and for 2-3 days after completing treatment
- If discomfort is bothersome, ointments such as Aquaphor or Vaseline can help soothe
 the area. <u>Plain</u> moisturizers, such as Vanicream or DML, can also help provide relief
 (especially if kept in refrigerator). Avoid moisturizers with harsh chemicals, as this will
 sting.

Aftercare:

- Apply healing ointment such as Vaseline, Aquaphor, or bacitracin 2-3 times/day as needed.
- If irritation/burning persists, you can also mix over the counter Hydrocortisone 1% with any of the above-mentioned ointments and apply 2-3 per day.
- Avoid exposing areas to the sun during and post treatment. If exposure must occur, please wear a hat, and apply SPF 30.
